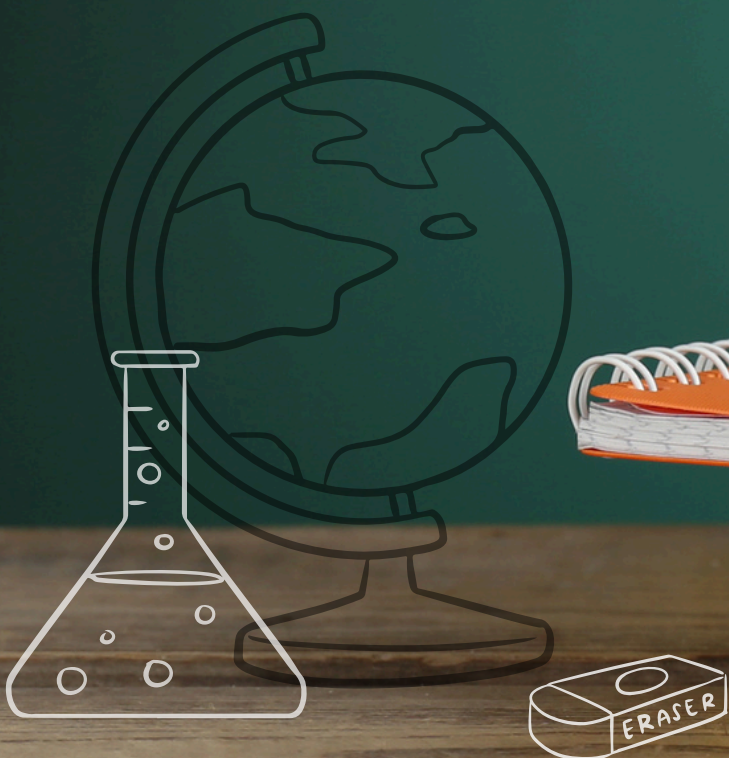

Drop Off & Dismissal Procedure

DROP OFF PROCEDURE

- SCHOOL HOURS FOR THE UPCOMING ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR WILL BE FROM 8:00 am - 3:15 pm
- Morning drop off begins at 7:50 AM and ends at 8:10 AM.
- All KG - 12th grade students must be dropped off at the school main entrance.
- Parents must get in the drop off line in front of the school and wait to be assisted by our staff members.
- If you arrive after 8:10 AM and our drop-off staff are no longer outside, you must park in a designated parking spot, walk your child inside the building and sign them in at the front office.
- Parents are required to walk their child into the building if they are arriving late.
- Cars must not be left unattended in front of the school entrance.
- Please follow security and dismissal staffs' directions to ensure a safe and smooth process.



DISMISSAL PROCEDURE

- Dismissal starts at 3:15 PM and ends at 3:30 PM.
- Each family will receive a Dismissal number on Orientation Day.
- Parents must remember this number and provide it verbally to our dismissal staff during pick up.
- *KG Students will be dismissed separately from the rest of the school. Please refer to KG dismissal section.
- 1st - 5th Grade students (who do not have siblings in KG) will be dismissed from the school main entrance.
- Please follow security and dismissal staffs' directions to ensure a safe and smooth process.
- If a parent is running late and cannot make the dismissal time, they must call and inform the office. See handbook for late fees.
- Parents are required to inform the school office if their child is getting picked up by someone other than authorized contacts.



KG DISMISSAL PROCEDURE

*KG DISMISSAL

- Kindergarten students and their siblings will be dismissed from the cafeteria.
- Parents must park in a designated parking spot and walk into the cafeteria from the side entrance.
- Parents are required to carry and show the assigned dismissal number to staff at dismissal.

No Phone Policy

NO PHONE POLICY 2025-2026

As we strive to create an optimal learning environment for our students, we are implementing a new policy regarding the use of phones, smart watches, and air-pods during school hours.

No Phones at School Policy:

Students are not permitted to have phones, smart watches, & air-pods during school hours. If a student must bring a phone to school, it must be dropped off at the front office daily, where it will be securely locked in a cabinet. If a student is found with a phone during school hours, the phone will be confiscated and held for one week. Parents may choose to retrieve the phone earlier by paying a \$100 fee.

This policy is designed to minimize distractions and ensure that students remain focused on their studies throughout the school day. We believe that reducing phone usage during school hours will contribute to a more effective and engaging learning environment for all students.

We appreciate your understanding and support in helping us enforce this policy.

CLASS DOJO

- Class Dojo is the primary method of communication between school teachers, students and their families.

PLUS PORTALS

School Lunches

PURCHASING SCHOOL LUNCHESES

Students will have the opportunity to purchase hot lunches at the school cafeteria with Lunch Cards. ADS offers 3 types of Lunch cards, each lunch meal is \$5.

- 20 Lunches - \$100
- 10 Lunches - \$50
- 5 Lunches - \$25

Lunch Cards can be purchased with cash, card or check at the school office. Lunch cards stay in school with the Cafeteria Manager. Parents will be notified via Class Dojo of the status of their child's lunch card.

Students must have a pre-paid lunch card to purchase lunch at school.
